She married Alexander Murray on May 4, 1784. He was born about 1760 in Scotland, and came to America on the same boat (with his parents and family) with Isabela's family. He was a soldier in the American Revolution which ended in 1783. d. 1845; bur. Galena, Ill. The burial place of Isabella Duguid Murray is not known.* She preceeded her husband in death by several years.* Her great grandson expressed deep regret as to this matter.
